Please read all of the directions carefully. The Prize committee will only consider those applications that are accurate and complete.

1. Complete the application, downloadable from <<http://www.yale.edu/aatfct/prizeinfo.html>>. Please type. Note: Please identify yourself as Category A or B.

Category A

\$500 Scholarship

Open to all students currently studying French who have had no experience or up to six weeks' experience in a French speaking country.

Category B

\$500 Scholarship

Open to all students currently studying French who have had more than six weeks' experience in a French speaking country. This category is also open to students living in a French speaking household.

2. Attach two (2) letters of recommendation. One must be from the French teacher who is nominating you, the other from an administrator, teacher or employer.

3. Enclose a sample of one of your essays done as a class assignment that has been graded (original graded work, not a photocopy).

4. Enclose an unofficial (student) copy of your high school transcript that includes test scores (SAT I and II, AP, if taken).

5. Your signature and your nominating teacher's are required on the application.

6. Return your application, letters of recommendation, and transcript **postmarked** by March 30, 2009 to:
