The iNet Internship Network is an internship posting database shared by Georgetown, MIT, Northwestern, Rice, Stanford, NYU, University of Pennsylvania and Yale. This database gives you access to a full range of internship opportunities in all industries.



You should continue to **use eRecruiting for Yale-affiliated programs** such as OCIP, Yale in Hollywood, International Bulldogs, etc; iNet is an additional tool to link you to independent internships throughout the US and beyond.

Logging in to iNet

Step 1: Click [here](https://inet-csm.symplicity.com/students) to go to the iNet student log-in page or use the following web address: <https://inet-csm.symplicity.com/students>

Step 2: In the log-in field, enter your Yale e-mail address as both your user name and password.

Step 3: Complete all required fields in the registration page and click the “Submit” button.

Step 4: Once you log-in you will need to change your password. This can be done by going to the “Profile” section and clicking on the “Password” tab. Make sure to click the “Save” button before you go to another screen.

Using iNet to search for internships

After you log in, click the “Internships” tab at the top of the page.

In the lower half of the screen you can view all internships posted in the database. These are listed by their posting date, most recent listed first.

In the top portion of the “Internships” section you have the option of choosing basic search criteria, or you can search using more specific search criteria by clicking on the “Advanced Search” tab.

To apply for internships posted in iNet, follow the instructions given by the employer in the position description. If no specific instructions are given in the description, you can submit your application materials to the employer through iNet by following the instructions in the “Application Status” section on the right hand side of the screen within the internship posting. You will need to have at least one document uploaded into the system to apply through iNet.
