WILLIAM AIKEN JR. '72 M.DIV. died on July 31, 2006, at the age of 59. Aiken served as a Professor of Philosophy and Religion at Chatham College for 29 years.

REV. ROBERT AIRHART '38 B.D. died on May 29, 2006, at the age of 92. A lifelong United Brethren/United Methodist minister, Airhart served congregations throughout Ohio.

REV. ROBERT ALLING '51 B.A., M.DIV. '81 died on February 1, 2006.

REV. NIGEL LYON ANDREWS '43 B.A., '56 BERKELEY died on January 19, 2006, in Newport, RI of congestive heart failure. He served during his seminary studies as Berkeley's business manager (he had a previous career as an attorney) and was a longtime vicar at St. Ann's Church in Old Lyme, CT.

DIX ASLESON '50 B.S., '53 M.DIV. died on December 1, 2005, at the age of 80. Known for his dedication to helping others, Asleson worked as a minister, a career and rehabilitation counselor, and an admissions counselor.

DWANE E. AVERILL '57 M.DIV. died on November 7, 2005.

REV. JAMES BABCOCK '58 BERKELEY died on November 10, 2005, at the age of 72. An Anglican priest, Babcock served congregations in Massachusetts and Maine and later worked in life insurance.

STEPHEN BACHELDER '44 B.D. died on November 10, 2005, at the age of 88. A lifelong Congregational minister, Bachelder served congregations in New York, New Jersey, and Massachusetts.

WILLIAM BARRETT '61 BERKELEY died on August 7, 2006, at the age of 73. An Episcopal priest, Barrett served in the diocese of Albany and also at the Pearl Street Counseling Center.

DOROTHY BECKER, spouse of former YDS professor Russell Becker, died on March 5, 2005, at the age of 82. Becker worked as a financial secretary.

LAWRENCE BENNETT '42 DIV. died on July 11, 2006, at the age of 88. Bennett served in the Navy Chaplain Corps during WWII, and later served Disciples of Christ congregations in Pennsylvania and West Virginia.

REV. ERNEST BIGELOW '42 B.D. died on December 31, 2005, at the age of 88. Bigelow served as a chaplain in the U.S. Army during WWII and later as a Presbyterian minister in Ohio.

SHIRLEY BRILL '99 M.DIV. died on April 23, 2006, at the age of 48. A lifelong resident of Cheshire, Brill was known for her love of education.

REV. JOHN BUCHANAN '59 DIV. died on July 17, 2006, at the age of 76. A gifted teacher and preacher, Buchanan, an Episcopal priest, was also a psychotherapist.

REV. FRANK BUECHLEY '48 B.D. died on August 1, 2005.

REV. KENNETH CAMERON '40 PH.D. BERKELEY died on February 8, 2006.

GEORGE COATS '63 M.A., '66 DIV., '66 PH.D. died on April 6, 2006.

REV. CHALMERS COE '43 B.A., '45 B.D. died on March 26, 2006, at the age of 83. Coe served Congregational churches in Connecticut, Massachusetts, and Ohio and was known for his focus on the integrity of the worship service.

REV. ROBERT CUMMINGS '51 BERKELEY died on March 14, 2006.

REV. JAMES DEFOE, SR. '42 B.D. died on April 10, 2006, at the age of 89. DeFoe, a Baptist minister, served congregations in Virginia.

DAVID ERNSBERGER '55 B.D. died on December 28, 2005, at the age of 75. A psychotherapist, Ernsberger also served as a Presbyterian minister in New York, Michigan, Ohio, Indiana, and Minnesota.

REV. WILLIAM FAUGHNAN '54 BERKELEY died on October 26, 2005, at the age of 81. Faughnan, a chaplain in the U.S. Army, served Episcopal congregations in Maryland, Illinois, Wisconsin, Virginia, and Florida.

JUDSON FIEBIGER '33 B.D. died on November 10, 2005, at the age of 100. A longtime Congregational minister, Fiebiger served congregations in New York, Florida, and Ohio, and also served as the Iowa UCC Conference Superintendent.

An ordained deacon in the Roman Catholic Church, Fournier also served as a high school French teacher and psychiatric social worker and therapist. REV. CARL GABRIELSEN JR. '82 M.DIV. died on July 19, 2006, at the age of 49. Gabrielsen, an ordained Lutheran pastor, served in both parishes and on college campuses in Tennessee, Iowa, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and Maryland.

E. CLINTON GARDNER '45 B.D., '52 PH.D. died on November 26, 2005, at the age of 85. Gardner served as Professor of Christian Ethics at Emory University and also served congregations in New York and Connecticut.

TERESA GEIGER '76 M.A.R. died on March 22, 2006, at the age of 74. A Dominican nun, Geiger taught school in Ohio, Michigan, and Connecticut, and later worked as a writer.

- GLENN OLDS '48 DIV., '48 PH.D.** died on March 11, 2006, at the age of 85. Committed to public service, Olds worked as a minister, professor, college president, ambassador, and statesman.
- REV. WAYNE OLMSTEAD '66 BERKELEY** died on March 13, 2006, at the age of 70. An Episcopal priest, Olmstead served in Wisconsin, Michigan, and Arkansas.
