## SCHOLARSHIPS ESTABLISHED AND GROWING

### DAVID H. KELSEY SCHOLARSHIP

The David H. Kelsey Scholarship was created by Professor Kelsey's friends and family to honor his life and work. It will be awarded annually to a Master of Divinity student intending to embark on a career in Christian ministry. In 2005, after 12 years as the Luther A. Weigle Professor of Theology, Kelsey '58 B.D., '60 M.A., '64 Ph.D. retired to write a book of theological anthropology.

### JOHN AND LYDIA NOTAR MORROW SCHOLARSHIP

The John and Lydia Notar Morrow Scholarship was established as a gift from Lydia Morrow '58 M.R.E. in memory of her late husband, John '55 B.D., and in recognition of their many years of ministry together. The scholarship is to be awarded annually to Divinity School students with a preference for Protestant students preparing for pastoral ministry.

### A. KNIGHTON STANLEY SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was founded by A. Knighton Stanley '62 B.D., his friends and family on the occasion of his retirement as senior pastor at Peoples Congregational Church in Washington, DC. The scholarship will be awarded annually to students from both Howard University School of Divinity and YDS who exemplify the kind of service practiced by Stanley and his family.

### BRENDA J. STIERS SCHOLARSHIP

The Brenda J. Stiers Scholarship was established by YDS Board of Advisors member Brenda Stiers '83 M.Div. The annual scholarship will benefit Divinity Students with a preference for those from the United Church of Christ. Stiers is a UCC pastor and former adjunct member of the YDS faculty.

### SAMUEL ARTHUR TODD SCHOLARSHIP

The Samuel Arthur Todd Scholarship was established by the Todd family and friends in honor of the life of Sam Todd '84 Div., who spent two and a half years as a student at YDS before disappearing mysteriously in New York City in 1984. The annual scholarship will be awarded to Yale Divinity School students who pay tribute to Todd's spirit by showing a deep interest in ministries committed to social justice.

### NELLE MARTIN TUGGLE SCHOLARSHIP

Established by Clyde C. Tuggle '88 M.Div., this scholarship for YDS students is a tribute to Tuggle's mother. Tuggle, the head of Coca-Cola's operations in Ukraine, Russia and Belarus, is a member of the YDS Board of Advisors who has been active in bringing leaders like former secretary of state Madeleine Albright to campus.
