**INTRO TO FINAL CUT PRO:** Essential FCP skills including capturing DV footage, managing files, basic editing, transitions, sound, exporting finished product

**INTRO TO DIGITAL VIDEO CAMERA:** Using the Canon XL-1s and GL-2 camera. tripods, exposure, focus, color balance, essential shooting techniques.

**VIDEO SHOOTING TECHNIQUES:** Shot composition, shooting a scene for editing, continuity, screen direction.

**INTRO TO LIGHTING:** Setting up lights, light quality and characteristics, the 3 point lighting set up.

**INTRO TO AFTER EFFECTS:** Essential After Effects skills and concepts- layers, transparency alpha channels and compositing, animation, keyframes, filters and final output.

**ADVANCED FINAL CUT PRO:** Off line logging, batch capturing, advanced trimming, using video layers, compositing, filters, color correction and titles.

**iDVD:** Using iDVD to author and burn a DVD-R

**INTRO TO DVD STUDIO PRO:** Preparing media for authoring, authoring in DVD SP3, burning a DVD.

**BEGINNING DREAMWEAVER:** Create and upload a basic multi-page site, with links, images, and interactive menus.

**PREPARING IMAGES FOR THE WEB:** Prepare digital photos, create text banners, and create a photo gallery with Photoshop.

**INTERMEDIATE DREAMWEAVER:** Hands-on examples using templates, library items, cascading style sheets, flash, forms, and more.

**EDITING EXISTING SITES IN DREAMWEAVER:** For inherited sites that need to be updated, covers downloading and uploading changes, using style sheets and updating images.
