ANNOUNCEMENT

The Tulane National Primate Research Center will offer a Summer Research Fellowship Program during June through August of 2006 for a small number of qualified pre- and post-baccalaureate students who are interested in biomedical research experience. The successful candidate will receive \$7.25 per hour (based on 37.5 hour week) for a maximum of three months.

Positions will be available in each of the following Divisions of the Primate Research Center: Comparative Pathology, Microbiology and Immunology, Bacteriology and Parasitology, Gene Therapy and Veterinary Medicine.

To be eligible for the Summer Research Fellowship Program, a student must have completed at least one year of undergraduate coursework in biology or biomedical related fields. All applicants must currently be undergraduate or graduate students in good standing and be strongly motivated to participate in on going research projects at the Primate Center. Participants will have an opportunity to present their research at the end-of-summer Research Symposium.

The Center is located on 500 wooded acres near Covington, Louisiana, 30 miles north of New Orleans.

Candidates interested in applying for this Program should send a letter containing an outline of their career goals, curriculum vitae, a transcript or record of their academic achievement and two letters of recommendation from faculty of their college or university to
