Table I. EPI Scores

- The legend incorrectly labels the order of the sparklines (p.3). The correct order (from left to right) is: Environmental Health, Biodiversity & Habitat, Sustainable Energy, Water Resources, Air Quality, and Productive Natural Resources.

Figure I. Map of EPI Scores by Quintile

- The Netherlands is incorrectly colored in the map. It should be in Quintile 1 (green);
- The Dominican Republic should be in Quintile 2 (blue).
- Nepal should be in Quintile 3 (yellow).
- Burundi should be in Quintile 5 (red).

Appendix B. Indicator Tables & Charts

- The indicator peer group charts for MORTALITY (p.74) should have the unit “Child Mortality, deaths per 1000 children aged 1-4 years old” not “percentage of deaths”.
- The target for the HARVEST indicator charts (p.94) should be 4, not 0.

Appendix C. Country Profiles

- The Target value for the PM10 indicator is 10 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, not 0 $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$.
- The proximity to target data for indoor air pollution has two conjoined values which bunch together the Value and the Standardized Proximity to Target (e.g. 72.028.0 or 100.00.0). The first of the two values is the correct one (e.g. 72.0 or 100.0).
