**HOW TO PLACE A LISTING**

Please complete the listing application form. List only one rental or house for rent per form. Be sure to fill in all appropriate sections. Landlords, homeowners and students listing sublets and shares are required to inform our office if their properties have been rented, sold or sublet prior to the expiration of the listing. **All listings are valid for 45 days. Landlords are required to notify Off Campus Housing upon rental of unit.**

- Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card.
- Payment receipts will only be issued to listings submitted in person.
- Please save your cancelled check if you mail your listing.
- The Off Campus Listing Service does not guarantee that you will receive calls or that your property will be rented or sold.
- Listing information is not retained after it has expired or has been deleted.

If a complaint is filed with an enforcement agency we may remove all listings placed by the defendant until the complaint is resolved. If it is proven that illegal discrimination has occurred, listings will not be re-entered into the system until we have received written certification that the landlord or agent will abide by the statutes in the future. We also reserve the right to remove listings and/or prohibit landlords from placing listings if: (1) substandard accommodations have been listed with Yale (verified by the Building Inspection Office) (2) there is evidence that the rights of tenants have been violated or that inaccurate information was provided to the Off Campus Listing Service.
