

WOMEN, RELIGION, AND GLOBALIZATION PROJECT

The Women, Religion, and Globalization Project at Yale invites proposals from Yale graduate, undergraduate and professional school students for summer projects that focus on women, religion and globalization. The project may include an internship. We are particularly interested in projects that explore the relationships between women's daily practices of religion and the processes of globalization. We will consider projects that involve collaboration among students, especially if they involve research across disciplines.

Awards of up to \$3000 will be made to current graduate, undergraduate and professional school students. The funds may be used for travel, domestically or internationally, and for living and research expenses.

Applications must include:

1. One completed application Registration Sheet found on www.studentgrants.yale.edu
2. This cover sheet and a completed application form.
3. A statement that discusses the project, including the location and duration, relating it to your academic program and career goals. It should explicitly discuss how your project relates to the issues of women, religion and globalization. (No more than two typed pages).
4. A budget of your total estimated expenses and all sources of revenue, including the funds requested in this proposal and funds requested elsewhere.
5. A copy of your most recent transcript. (An unofficial copy is acceptable.)
6. Name and contact information of two Yale faculty members who can comment knowledgably on your application.

Applications must be received by 4 pm, Friday, February 29, to be considered.

Completed applications should be submitted to the International Affairs Council at the MacMillan Center, Luce Hall, 34 Hillhouse, Room 210. For more information, contact the International Affairs Council at 432-6253. Decisions will be announced in late April.
