

# Auerbach Grayson/Leitner International Internships

## Summer 2008

**Auerbach Grayson/Leitner International Internships** support internships for Yale College sophomores and juniors in brokerage and/or investment banking firms in developing countries. All of the internship sites are international affiliates of Auerbach Grayson, an international brokerage firm based in New York. **Internship sites for summer 2008 will be in African financial services firms.** Prospective candidates are encouraged to visit the Auerbach Grayson website [www.agco.com](http://www.agco.com) to learn more about Auerbach Grayson and its affiliate firms prior to applying. Last year's internship sites included Nedcor Securities in Johannesburg, Upline Securities in Casablanca, Ata Invest in Istanbul, Swissport in Dar es Salaam, MBEA Brokerage Services in Kampala and CSL Stockbrokers in Lagos.

The internships are intended to provide international work experience and to complement language study and other academic pursuits. Grants are intended to subsidize transportation and living expenses while working in an uncompensated position at the firm for a minimum of eight weeks. Approximately six internships will be awarded for summer 2008.

Candidates will be selected on the basis of their academic and extracurricular activities, the potential impact that this internship will have on their academic and career plans, and their foreign language skills. Some preference will be given to students with relatively less prior international travel experience. Candidates whose language skills match the main language of the proposed countries may have some competitive advantage in the selection process; however, students with language skills not matching the main language of the proposed countries are welcome to apply. Students will not be selected for internships in their home countries.

Award recipients must submit a report of their internship by October 1, 2008.

Applications must include:

2. One completed application cover sheet (attached).
3. A brief summary of the links between the internship, your academic program, and your career plans. **Please do not exceed one page in length. Email your summary to [tara.stevens@yale.edu](mailto:tara.stevens@yale.edu).**
4. A copy of your most recent transcript.
5. A one page resume.
6. One letter of recommendation from a Yale Faculty member.

**Deadline.** Applications must be received by **4 pm Friday, February 1, 2008** to be considered. **It is the applicant's responsibility to see that the complete application, including evaluation letter and transcripts, reaches the MacMillan Center, suite 306 by the deadline; applications cannot be considered without this information.** Applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision by mail in early May.
