Awards of up to \$3,000 will be awarded to current Ph.D. candidates at Yale to support intensive structured training in a European language during the summer of 2008. Preference will be given to Ph.D. candidates pursuing area studies dissertation research related to Europe.

2. One completed application cover sheet.
3. A brief description of the location and duration of the European language study program for which you seek support, and an indication of how this program will contribute to your dissertation research. (Copy of your application to the program and basic information on brochure from the program).
4. A budget of your total estimated travel and program expenses and all sources of revenue including funds requested in this application and all available Graduate School summer sources.
5. Attestation by a faculty member of current proficiency in the language to be studied.
6. A copy of your most recent transcript (an unofficial copy is acceptable).

Deadline: Applications must be received by **4pm, Friday, February 29, 2008** to be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to see that the complete application reaches the European Studies Council, The MacMillan Center, Room 242, Luce Hall, 34 Hillhouse Avenue by the deadline. Applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision by late April.
