The Ganzfried Family Travel Fellowship provides support for undergraduate and graduate students on all subjects related to communal and religious tolerance and understanding security and cooperation, natural and economic resources, environmental, scientific and technological collaboration and development, communication, culture, gender and family in Israel or for academic work elsewhere in the field of Jewish studies. Amounts can vary up to \$2,500.

3. A brief description (1-2 pages) of the proposed project including the location and approximate start and end dates of travel for which you seek support.

4. A budget of your total estimated travel expenses and all sources of revenue including funds requested in this application.

5. A copy of your most recent transcript (unofficial copy is acceptable).

6. One letter of evaluation from a Yale faculty member who can comment knowledgeably on your application.

7. A one page resume

A written report of the experience must be submitted at the completion of the award. As a result of the award, recipients may be asked to offer a presentation of their field project results to the Yale campus. Any publication or public presentations resulting from these projects should acknowledge the support of the "Ganzfried Family Travel Fellowship."

Deadline. Applications must be received by **4pm Monday, March 3, 2008** to be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to see that the complete application reaches the Middle East Studies Council, The MacMillan Center, Room 232, Luce Hall, 34 Hillhouse Avenue by the deadline. Applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision by early May.
