- (a) The [Peking University-Yale University Joint Undergraduate Program](#) was established in 2006 and students were enrolled for the first time in the Fall of 2006.
- (b) For Fall 1999 a breakdown of special students was not available therefore all specials have been put into the "non-degree" category.
- (c) Totals include 5th and 6th year students registered in "less than half time" status, "in absentia paying tuition" and special students. Students on leave of absence and students registered as "dissertation submission" are excluded.
- (d) The enrollment figures for each school include only those students paying tuition to that school in the Fall term. Enrollment also includes students registered as "special" and, beginning Fall 2005, "in absentia paying tuition" students are also included. "Leave of absence" students are excluded. Beginning Fall 2005, visiting scholars are not included in the Law School enrollments. Students enrolled in Ph.D. programs that are affiliated with the professional schools (e.g., Medicine, Law, etc.) are counted in the Graduate School.
- (e) Fall 2005 enrollment includes 24 students displaced by Hurricane Katrina: Yale College - 11; Graduate School of Arts & Sciences - 6; Drama School - 2; Law School 2; Epidemiology & Public Health - 3.
