**Notes:** Course registrations for multiple-titled courses are divided evenly among the two or more crosslisting departments. Because of this, the totals will not always equal the sum of the given rounded numbers. Graduate level courses in which Yale College students are enrolled are counted.

- (a) In Fall 1998, the Department of African and African American Studies changed its name to African American Studies. The major in African & African American Studies is now two separate majors: African American Studies and African Studies. The African Studies program has moved from the Department of African American Studies to the Yale Center for International & Area Studies.
- (b) Beginning in the 1998-99 academic year, the Department of Biology reorganized to form the Department of Ecology & Evolutionary Biology (EEB) and the Department of Molecular, Cellular & Developmental Biology (MCDB). Students in the classes of 1999, 2000, and 2001 will be able to complete their major in Biology.  
Beginning in the 2001-02 academic year, the majors in EEB & MCDB are discontinued. The major in Biology was reinstated and is offered jointly by the departments of EEB and MCDB. EEB and MCDB students in the classes of 2002, 2003, and 2004 may complete their majors.
- (c) Biomedical Engineering was added as a new major in 1997/98; Environmental Engineering was added as a new major in 1998/99.
- (d) The major in British Studies was terminated in 1986/87. Courses are still offered each year at the Paul Mellon Centre in London.
- (e) Cognitive Science was added as a new major in 1999/2000.
- (f) Environmental Studies was added as a new major in 2001/02. Prior to 2001/02 the program was called Studies in the Environment and could be taken only as a second major.
- (g) Ethnicity, Race and Migration was added as a new major in 1997/98. It may be taken only as a second major.
- (h) Ancient and Modern Greek was added as a new major in 2002/03.
- (i) South Asian Studies was added as a new major in 2007/08. It may be taken only as a second major.
- (j) Organismal Biology was added as a new major in 1991/92. Effective Fall, 1998, the program has been incorporated into the Department of Ecology & Evolutionary Biology.
- (k) Includes Cell Biology, Cellular & Molecular Physiology, Experimental Pathology, Genetics, Immunobiology, Medicine, Microbiology, Neurobiology, Neuroscience, Pathology, Pharmacology, and Psychiatry.
- (l) Includes Biostatistics, Chronic Disease Epidemiology, Environmental Health Sciences, EPH, Epidemiology Infectious Disease, Epidemiology Microbial Disease, Global Health, Health Policy Administration, Health Policy Resources & Administration, International Health, Mental Health, Public Health, Microbiology, Public Health Practice, and Health & Policy Resources.
