Note:

(a) From 1979-80 on, these counts include full-time instructional faculty in all of Yale's schools except the School of Medicine. Before 1979-80, the counts also exclude the School of Nursing. Deans are not included, nor are faculty on leave without salary. Eleven-month salaries are converted to a nine-month basis. "Lecturer Convertible" is a title given to successful candidates for assistant professorships who have not completed their Ph.Ds at the time their appointments began. Beginning in 2000-01, full-time lecturers are included with "Lecturer and Other."

Beginning in 2003, Yale's submission to the AAUP survey includes all full-time instructional faculty and includes variants of the professor title as professors. For example, in 2003 the Yale figures for "professor" include Professor Adjunct, Clinical Professor of Law, and Professor of the Practice. This change added 55 faculty to the professor category in 2003, 16 to associate professor, and six to assistant professor. This expanded definition of the ranks reduced the mean salary in 2003 by 2.6% for professors, 3.4% for associate professors, and 0.3% for assistant professors, compared with what the mean would have been without these faculty. Any comparison of salaries in 2003 and later to salaries before 2003 should take this effect into account.
