<b>Table 1.a.</b>	<b>Activities One Year After Graduation</b>
	This table is based on survey data and presents the activities reported by the Class of 2006 during the 2006-07 academic year. It includes comparisons with the activities reported by the Classes of 2004, 2002 and 2000.
<b>Table 1.b.</b>	<b>Plans to Study in the Future</b>
	If not already attending graduate/professional school, graduates were asked if they planned to do so in the next year or two. This table is based on survey data and reports the responses of the 670 graduates who answered the question.
<b>Table 2</b>	<b>Area of Concentration and Graduation Standing</b>
	This reference table shows the number of degrees awarded with general honors within each of the areas of study for the entire Class of 2006 and not just for the respondents of this survey. It may be a good source of reference when reading Tables 4 and 5.
<b>Table 3</b>	<b>Distribution of Graduates by Undergraduate Major</b>
	This reference table reports the areas in which the graduates of the entire Class of 2006 majored. It includes comparisons with the Classes of 2004, 2002, and 2000. It may be a good source of reference when reading Table 4.
<b>Table 4.a.</b>	<b>Activities One Year After Graduation by Undergraduate Major Group</b>
	This table is based on survey data and presents the activities reported by the Class of 2006 during the 2006-07 academic year summarized by the undergraduate major group of the respondents.
<b>Table 4.b.</b>	<b>Activities One Year After Graduation by Yale College Major</b>
	This table is based on survey data and presents the activities reported by the Class of 2006 during the 2006-07 academic year summarized by the undergraduate major subject of the respondents.
<b>Table 5</b>	<b>Activities One Year After Graduation by Graduate Standing</b>
	This table is based on survey data and presents the activities reported by the Class of 2006 during the 2006-07 academic year by the graduate standing of the respondents (i.e., whether or not they graduated with honors).
<b>Table 6</b>	<b>Graduate and Professional Schools Chosen</b>
	This table is based on survey data and reports the graduate and professional schools chosen by the graduates who enrolled in graduate study during the 2006-07 academic year. It includes comparisons with the Classes of 2004, 2002, and 2000.
<b>Table 7</b>	<b>Summary Table of Post-Graduation Activities for the Classes of 1960 to 2006</b>
	This table summarizes the major areas of post-graduation activities, going back to the first class of students surveyed.
<b>Table 8</b>	<b>Summary Table of the Type of Graduate Study Chosen by Yale College Graduates Who Are Attending Graduate School for the Classes of 1968 to 2006</b>
	For those class members who attended graduate or professional school the year following graduation, this table summarizes the area of study in which graduates were enrolled.
<b>Table 9</b>	<b>Summary Table of the Types of Employment for Graduates Choosing Employment for the Class of 1968 to 2006</b>
	For those class members who were employed the year following graduation, this table summarizes the areas of employment in which graduates were engaged.
