

# YALE UNIVERSITY POLICE DEPARTMENT CITIZEN POLICE ACADEMY

## Goal

To provide an increased understanding and awareness of police operations, responsibilities and capabilities and to promote the partnership between the police department and the community.

## Course Description

- The Citizen Police Academy will be held: evenings from 6:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Yale Police Department, 101 Ashmun Street, New Haven.

## How do I apply to the Academy?

2. Once registered, YPD will contact each applicant to arrange for a criminal history check.
