### TRAINING CERTIFICATES NOW AVAILABLE FOR ALL POSTDOCS!

Postdoctoral Affairs now offers certificates to Postdocs campus-wide upon completion of training. These certificates will display your name, departmental affiliation, and dates of your training and also contain the embossed seal of Postdoctoral Affairs. To request a certificate before you leave Yale, please have your departmental business office contact either Abby (Medical School) or Alisa (Central Campus). We can usually generate a certificate in two to three business days.

*Medical School:* Certificates are not available to Postdocs who completed their training prior to November 1, 2004.

*Central Campus:* Certificates are not available to Postdocs who completed their training prior to January 1, 2008.
