Meet the Postdoc Advisory Committee!

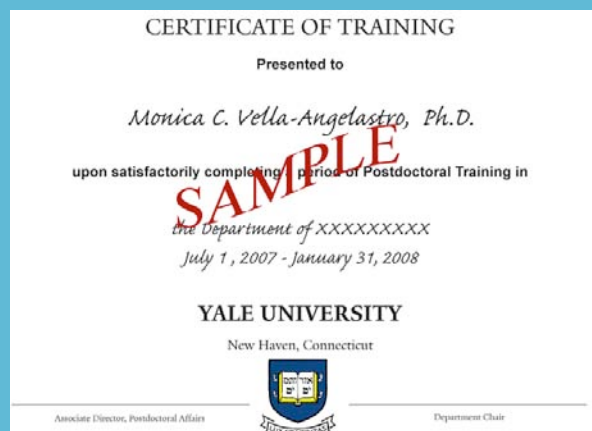

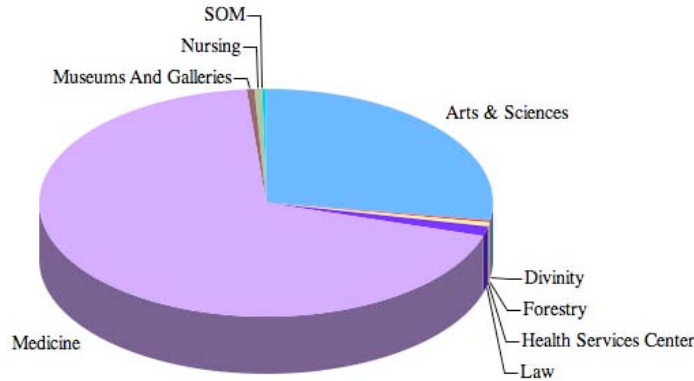

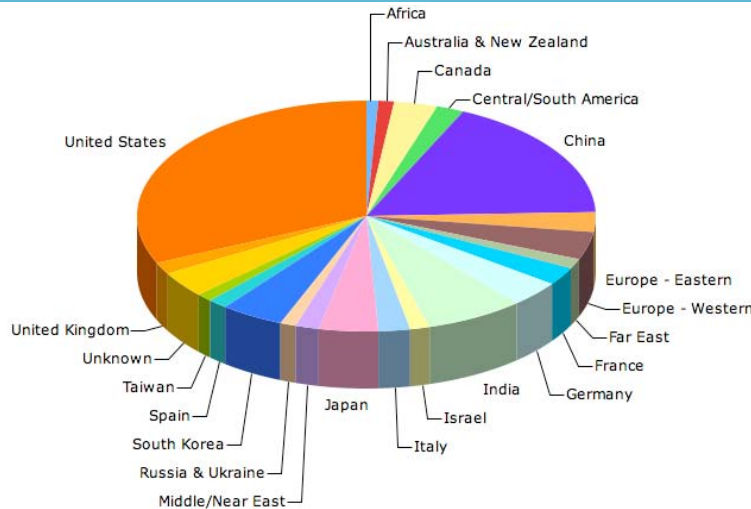
