



# Watch Your Step for Safety

**Allow plenty of time to cross streets. Don't run to cross streets.**

**Use the crosswalk** and don't assume drivers see you unless they signal for you to cross.

**Wait for a “fresh green” when crossing at signals.** Don't start to cross the street unless the traffic signal has just turned green.

**Stop and look for traffic in all directions before crossing the street, and look to the left, right, and left again—even on a one-way street.**

**Don't rely only on traffic signs and signals.** Assuming that a signal will stop traffic puts you at risk. You must look for traffic even if you are in a crosswalk and you are crossing with the light or with the walk signal.

**Turning vehicles can be especially dangerous at intersections. Look carefully before you step off the curb.**
