

A Note to Parents of our Freshmen:

Applying for Financial Aid for 2010-2011

The application process for continuing students begins later than the process for applicants. Continuing students will receive an email in January or early February with instructions on renewing their financial aid application for next year.

Spring Term Bills

The spring term bill will be generated on November 2. If you have not been receiving emails allowing you to access the monthly account statements, please ask your student to include you as an authorized user/payer in his/her E-bill records. The spring term bill is due December 1.

Spring Term Abroad

Holiday Travel

Travel expenses are included in the budgets that accompany financial aid awards. The travel allowance is an estimate of the cost of 2 round trips—to and from campus for the academic year and winter break. The travel allowance budget line varies according to state/country of residence. Allowances are standard and cannot be adjusted for individual costs. Refunds for travel expenses are available only if the credits paid to the student account exceed the charges.
