

Program Components Available as Named Endowments

Fellowship in Inter-Religious Dialogue **\$1,000,000**
An annual event promoting understanding between Muslims, Jews, Christians and other religious traditions.

Catholic Volunteer Corps **\$1,000,000**
Recent college graduates work as interns in the ministry of the Church at the St. Thomas More Chapel.

Annual More House Lecture **\$500,000**
A lecture, with publication, with a distinguished theologian

Ambassadors Program **\$500,000**
Alternative Spring Break projects and summer work experiences enable students to reflect on issues of social justice in the Tradition of Catholic Social Teaching.

Retreats **\$500,000**
Offers students extended times for prayer and attentiveness to spiritual growth.

Catholic Faculty Series **\$250,000**
Four-six times a year a Catholic faculty member speaks on his/her journey of faith.

Scholars Program **\$250,000**
Provides a stipend each semester for a select number of students to take courses in theology, meet with the Chaplain, participate in a retreat and focus on leadership training.

Mentoring Program **\$250,000**
Provides a stipend each semester for a select number of students to tutor/mentor poor students in Catholic elementary schools in New Haven.

Endowment for Concerts in Sacred Music **\$250,000**
Provides opportunities to present the Church's rich tradition of Sacred Music in concerts and other venues.

Cathletics **\$250,000**
Students explore the spirituality of the College athlete with invited speakers.
