Chardonnay Jardinale, France, 2001
~ Clean, medium-bodied with vibrant flavors of pear and honeydew

Pinot Grigio La Francesca, Italy, 2001
~ Light, crisp and refreshing with zesty citrus notes

Red

Cabernet Sauvignon Bluestone, Chile, 2001
~ Full and rich, this Cab packs a punch of black currants with baking spices

Merlot Jardinale, France, 2001
~ Smooth, medium-bodied with classic merlot flavors of black cherry and plum spices

White

Sauvignon Blanc Cooper's Creek, New Zealand, 2002 **\$16**
From one of the best places for sauvignon blanc in the world, this New Zealand treasure is a steal, with fresh, crisp, and cool citrus flavors and slight herbal notes.

Pinot Grigio Kris, Italy, 2002 **\$16**
This Italian pinot is a classic, showing crisp green apple and lemon flavors. Bright, lively, and with a clean finish. A definite crowd pleaser.

Reisling Wynns, Australia, 2001 **\$18**
Wonderful with spicier dishes, this soft, fruity reisling is not as sweet as its German expression, but full-flavored with a well balanced, bracing acidity.

Chardonnay Hess Select, California, 2001 **\$20**
Quite simply a great chardonnay. Rich tropical fruits are evident in the nose followed by ripe apple, peach, honey, butter, and spice. Yum!

Meritage Ca Del Solo, California, 2002 **\$18**
Blend of reisling, muscat, chenin blanc, colombard, pinot blanc, viognier, sauvignon blanc, pinot gris, and morsonne. This California white quite literally has it all. Fruity yet complex, it's a unique and versatile blend that is perfect for the summer.

Red

Cabernet Sauvignon Wynns, Australia, 2000 **\$20**
Outstanding cabernet from down under! Rich and full-bodied, with concentrated cherry notes, hints of cedar and mint and a long, luxurious finish.

Shiraz Lindeman, 2001 Reserve **\$18**
A rare reserve treat! Deep and jammy, loaded with black berries, plums, and spices and rounded off with a bit of toasty oak. Full and fruit-forward.

Pinot Noir Echelon, California, 2001 **\$18**
Wonderfully silky and versatile, this medium-bodied red blends flavors of red currants, raspberries, and cola in a smooth, clean finish.

Merlot Finca Luzon, Spain, 2001 **\$16**
A surprising and delightful merlot from Spain. Smooth and supple with bright cherry notes backed up with rich earth tones and a toasty finish. Que bueno!
