Instructions for Your Healthcare Provider

Health Professions Immunization Requirements (YSM, YSN, & PA Programs)

Documentation of the following list of immunizations is required in order for the student to enroll in Yale University.

Requirements:

➤ **Measles, Mumps and Rubella:**

2 doses or a positive titer. Dose #1 on or after first birthday. Dose #2 at least 30 days after 1st dose and after 1/1/80. If documentation of MMR vaccinations is not available, draw a titer for measles, mumps and rubella. Positive titer results will satisfy this requirement. If titer is negative, administer two (2) MMR vaccines not less than 30 days apart. Documentation of a positive laboratory result must be attached to the Vaccination Record.

If single vaccines:

Measles:

Documentation of two (2) measles vaccinations given on or after the student's first birthday and given at least 30 days apart.

The second measles vaccine must have been given on or after January 1, 1980.

If the student does not meet this requirement, administer two (2) MMR vaccines not less than 30 days apart.

Mumps:

Documentation of two (2) mumps vaccinations given on or after the student's first birthday and given at least 30 days apart.

The second mumps vaccine must have been given on or after January 1, 1980.

If the student does not meet this requirement, administer two (2) MMR vaccines not less than 30 days apart.

Rubella:

Documentation of one (1) rubella vaccination given on or after January 1, 1969.

If the student does not meet this requirement, administer rubella or MMR vaccine now.

- **Meningococcal Quadrivalent Vaccine:**
Acceptable vaccines include Menactra[®] (MCV4), Mencevax[®], ACYW Vax[®] and Menomune[®] (MPSV4). One dose is required on or after January 1, 2005. (Required for all students living in campus housing.)

- **Varicella:**
Proof of two doses of varicella vaccine is required or date of illness or positive titer results. Attach titer results to the Vaccination Record.

- **Tetanus:**
One (1) dose of Td or Tdap must have been administered after January 1, 2000. If the student was immunized prior to January 2000, immunize now with Tdap vaccine.

- **Polio:**
Proof of childhood vaccination is required. If this cannot be provided, the student must receive one (1) IPV immunization.

- **Hepatitis B Titer:**
Documentation of a positive quantitative hepatitis B titer is required. Attach a copy of the titer result to your Vaccination Record.

- **Hepatitis B:**
All students are required to complete the series of three (3) doses of hepatitis B vaccine.

- **PPD:**
Only the result of a PPD tuberculin 5 T.U. (Mantoux TB test), performed after January 2009 will be accepted. We do not accept multiple puncture tests such as TINE, Monovac, etc. TB test reaction must be documented in millimeters (we **cannot** accept a simple reading of positive or negative) and signed by a healthcare professional. The reaction must be read within 48 to 72 hours after the test is administered. If the PPD result is positive (10mm or greater), attach a chest x-ray result and treatment record.

- **Titer Results:**
In the event that any blood titer result was equivocal or borderline, please vaccinate student appropriately.

- **Vaccination Records:**
All immunization records must be documented in the English language.
