INSTRUCTIONS

Any member of the Yale College faculty or assistant or associate dean of Yale College is eligible to be your sophomore adviser, unless you plan to major in a program in the sciences and mathematics. In that case your sophomore adviser must be the appropriate DUS or a representative designated by that department. In all cases your sophomore adviser is the one who approves and signs your schedule for fall and spring terms of your sophomore year.

It is important to select an adviser with whom you feel comfortable in order to discuss seriously your course selections and your education in general. Most members of the faculty are happy to serve as advisers during your sophomore year. You may choose to continue with your freshman adviser (if her or she is a member of the Yale College faculty or an associate or assistant dean in Yale College), approach the instructor of a course you completed this year, or consult with a faculty fellow of your college who teaches in a department that interests you. Directors of undergraduate studies and designated departmental representatives are especially valuable as advisers.
