Orbitz for Business (OFB) is pleased to inform you of the latest product, feature and service enhancements contained in this release.

SECURE FLIGHT CHANGES

OFB is improving how you store personal information to prepare for a seamless transition to the Secure Flight program. When the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) implements this program later this year, you and your travelers will be ready and will continue to have an uninterrupted travel experience.

The Secure Flight program conducts pre-screening of passenger information against federal government watch lists for domestic and international flights. Secure Flight is designed to facilitate air travel and the screening and boarding processes, while adding additional layers of protection from security threats.

The TSA collects the minimum amount of personal information necessary to conduct effective watch list matching. This information is:

- › Full name
- › Gender
- › Date of birth

My Profile Changes

OFB has expanded the information you enter on the *My Profile* page to support Secure Flight. In addition to the existing personal information (first name, last name and suffix), you can now enter your full middle name, your gender and your date of birth. Your gender and date of birth are encrypted on OFB. Although not required for Secure Flight, you can also enter your title, like Mr. or Ms., if you have one.

You should confirm that the name stored in your OFB profile matches exactly the full name on the valid, government-issued photo ID you use when traveling. Failure to enter this information correctly may result in additional screening at the airport and, potentially, denied boarding.

Updating Secure Flight information

To update the information in *My Profile* for Secure Flight:

1. In the *Name* area at the top of the page, review the information that may already be filled in, and make any updates needed.
2. If your name includes a title, such as “Dr.” or “Mrs.” you can select it from the **Title** drop-down list.
3. In the **First/given name** box, check that your first or given name matches your ID.
4. In the **Middle name** box, enter your middle name or initial to match your ID.
5. In the **Last name/surname** box, check that your last name or surname matches your ID.
6. If your name includes a suffix, such as “Jr.” or “III,” select it from the **Suffix** drop-down list.
7. In the new *Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Information* area, select if you are male or female from the **Gender** drop-down list.
8. In the **Date of birth** box, enter the day when you were born.

Your gender and date of birth are encrypted to protect your privacy.

Future updates

The TSA has set these dates for future updates for the airlines:

- › By August 15, 2009, all airlines must have the ability to collect, store, gather and send passenger information for domestic flights to the TSA.
- › By October 31, 2009, this ability is required for international flights.

All dates are based on the most recent information received by OFB and are subject to change.

Once the airlines notify OFB to begin sending the required Secure Flight passenger information to them, the stored information from the traveler's profile will automatically be included in the booking path and transmitted to the airlines at the time the reservation is made.

This passenger information is transmitted by the airlines to the TSA at least 72 hours prior to scheduled flight departure time. If a reservation is made within 72 hours of flight departure time, the passenger information will be transmitted by the airlines to the TSA at the same time the reservation is made.
